Introduction

Welcome to Hiring for Hope's **Voices of Hope**, a free, safe, informative and supportive **online networking and support community!** We encourage anyone over the age of 15 to join. Whether you are trying to find your next job, next career, or make the best out of your current situation – there are others out there just like you. Your use of this network is subject to these Community Guidelines and is intended for **personal use for career management purposes only**.

Please be aware that this environment is heavily monitored and will be protected at all times. By following these Community Guidelines, we can make our Voices of Hope community a truly useful resource for job seekers.

Community Intent

This environment is designed to be a welcoming, open, positive, safe and non-judgmental space that respects, listens, and provides support and HOPE to each participant. It is a supportive place for you to share your story and experiences with others, and feel comfortable collaborating and networking with others so you realize that you are not alone. We encourage shared opinions and informative discussions between members who may have different points of view. However, please be polite and respectful in your interactions with other members at all times.

Rules of Engagement

Following is a list of our **Rules of Engagement** which were written to preserve this space for its intended use, and eliminate any confusion. Thank you in advance for your understanding and compliance with the following:

- 1. Expressing a non-supportive view regarding any of the issues for which we provide services and support is prohibited. There are numerous other organizations for this purpose. We suggest you join them instead.
- 2. Any solicitation of our members without the prior written consent of an official Hiring for Hope company representative in any way is strictly prohibited. Please be aware that we continually monitor all content in our Voices of Hope and mainstream social network communities. If you are here for this purpose, don't bother, your account will be immediately deactivated without a warning. Please also know that we are very savvy when it comes to social media. We know what solicitations masquerading as spam, "friend requests", and comments look like. Please don't waste anyone's time.





- 3. This network is for personal use for career management purposes only. If we see promotional posts or content that doesn't relate to the general premise of this group (career management), we will delete them and your account immediately. This no tolerance approach is not intended to offend or upset anyone—it is intended to help push forward the best content and opportunities to connect, and to stop shameless self-promotion. Hiring for Hope's Voices of Hope network is aimed at helping one another, not an all-access lead list.
- 4. You may not sell or promote yourself and/or any fee based services of any kind. This community is explicitly focused on providing great content and advice, and therefore we do not endorse any fee-based product or service for job seekers unless it has been previously cleared in writing by us. Any overt advertising of fee-based offerings will be immediately deleted and will result in your account being deactivated and your name and email blocked by our Social Media Monitoring Team.
- A. We realize that there are some terrific authors of content who have great advice to dispense. If you are such an author, we ask that you focus on those aspects of your business that are free, including content, advice, articles, etc. This is to avoid any confusion or perception of "bait-and-switch" tactics under the guise of "free help".
- B. We operate our own job placement services. Consequently, if you represent a search firm, you may not sell your services, headhunt our members, or promote your organization in any way without prior written authorization to do so. However, as our only interest is in helping job seekers find gainful employment, we are open to exploring creative national partnership arrangements that will help us collectively get job seekers back to work more quickly.

Community Guidelines

Content/Tone/Privacy

Profiles, Actions, and Other Posted Materials

- You are personally responsible for any content that you publish
- All content should be submitted in English
- You control how, and to what extent, the content you contribute is shared with other members
- Be sure to adjust your Privacy Settings to your desired comfort level upon joining.

Hiring for Hope provides a venue through which members of the public may create profiles, create actions and post other user content on the **Voices of Hope** social network. Zero tolerance policy for inappropriate material

Copyright

It's probably just a misunderstanding. Please contact them and politely ask them to remove it. If this approach is not effective, then let us know.

If you repeatedly infringe on others' intellectual property rights, we will disable your account.

Safety

We do our best to keep **Voices of Hope** safe, but we need your help. Please be aware of and commit to the following:
